AC Milan Crowned Women's Primavera Champions

The 2025–26 Women's Primavera season ended in unforgettable fashion as AC Milan Women were crowned Italian champions after a fantastic Final Four played in Sassuolo.

After months of intense competition, the league standings confirmed the four strongest sides of the season:

AS Roma Women, Juventus Women, AC Milan Women, and US Sassuolo Women. Their consistency, tactical quality, and ability to develop young talent earned them a place in the Final Four, the decisive stage of the championship.

Throughout the regular season, Roma impressed with their organization and defensive solidity, while Juventus once again showcased the strength of their youth academy with technical quality and attacking football. Sassuolo proved to be one of the revelations of the campaign, combining intensity and courage to challenge the traditional powerhouses of Italian women's football.

Milan, however, showed exceptional growth over the course of the season. Under the guidance of coach Mr. Zago, the Rossonere developed a clear identity built on possession, balance, and aggressive attacking play. Match after match, the team demonstrated maturity and confidence, becoming one of the most entertaining and complete sides in the league.

The Final Four began on Saturday, May 9, 2026, at the Mapei Center in Sassuolo. In the first semifinal, Milan defeated Juventus in a hard-fought encounter, confirming the quality and character they had shown all season long. In the second semifinal, Sassuolo overcame Roma to secure a historic place in the final in front of their home supporters.

The title match took place on Monday, May 11, at the Stadio Ricci in Sassuolo, where Milan and Sassuolo battled for the Primavera crown in an unforgettable final.

The game was fiercely contested from start to finish. Milan took the lead twice during regular time thanks to goals from Vitale and Strauss, but Sassuolo refused to surrender. Deep into stoppage time, in the 92nd minute, Sassuolo found a dramatic equalizer that sent the match into extra time and eventually to a penalty shootout.

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When the pressure reached its highest point, Milan goalkeeper Belloli emerged as the hero of the night, saving two penalties and giving the Rossonere the advantage in the shootout.

The decisive moment came when Cortinovis calmly converted the winning penalty, sparking celebrations among the Milan players, staff, and supporters.

This triumph was the perfect conclusion to a remarkable season for Milan. The Rossonere showcased not only determination and resilience, but also some of the best football in the league, reflecting the excellent work done by Mr. Zago throughout the year.

Several players played a crucial role in Milan's championship-winning campaign. Captain Sofia Pomati was an almost unbeatable presence in defense, providing leadership and solidity at the back. Karen Appiah made the difference with her pace, energy, and important goals throughout the season, while Elena Vitale brought quality, intelligence, and balance to the midfield, becoming one of the team's key figures.

Milan's victory in the Women's Primavera championship represents much more than a trophy. It is a statement about the club's growing investment in women's football and the bright future of a generation of talented young players ready to make their mark at the highest level.
